

and to use the amount so transferred for the redemption of the outstanding bonds of the loan of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-three (1873). And the State Treasurer is also by this act authorized to transfer to the redemption fund created by the act approved January twelfth (12th) one thousand eight hundred and eighty-three (1883), any balances there may be in the sinking fund, the seed grain sinking fund and the interest fund, after redeeming the balance of the loan of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-three (1873), and the coupons on the bonds so redeemed and the coupons on the bonds of the loan of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878) authorized to be refunded by said act of January twelfth (12th).

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 145.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF AN ASSISTANT BY THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Assistant Su-
perintendent of
Public Instruc-
tion—Salary.

SECTION 1. That the Superintendent of Public Instruction be required to appoint an assistant, who shall be known as Assistant Superintendent, to perform such service in the department as may be assigned him by the Superintendent, and that his salary be fifteen hundred dollars (\$1500) per annum.

Other clerks.

SEC. 2. That the Superintendent of Public Instruction be allowed to employ necessary clerical assistance, at a rate not exceeding fifty dollars (\$50) per month, or six hundred dollars (\$600) for any year.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
