

For purchasing of land, eight thousand four hundred dollars (\$8,400.00).

For improving center building and making basement of same fire proof, three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00).

For building new fire proof laundry, five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00).

Appropriation

pital for 1884.

*Fourth.*—For second hospital for insane, to be drawn from state institutions fund:

For building coal house, ice house, area wall, and for flagging, six thousand dollars (\$6,000.00).

For building carpenter ——— and other work shops, and fire proof vault, two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00).

For heating and plumbing new west wing, and for furnishing and lighting, eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000.00).

*Fifth.*—For second hospital for insane, to be drawn from the general revenue fund:

For purchase of land, ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00).

For building new west wing, and connecting tunnel and drainage, sixty-five thousand dollars (\$65,000.00).

All funds mentioned in the third, fourth and fifth divisions of this section, to be available for the year one thousand eight hundred eighty-four.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force, from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 158.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE UNPAID EXPENSES OF THE IMPEACHMENT TRIAL OF E. ST JULIEN COX, JUDGE OF THE DISTRICT COURT OF THE NINTH (9TH) JUDICIAL DISTRICT.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

Appropriation  
for impeach-  
ment trial.

SECTION 1. The sum of twelve thousand five hundred and thirty-one dollars and five cents (\$12,531.05), or so much thereof as may be necessary is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated for the payment of the unpaid expenses of the trial of the impeachment of E. St. Julien Cox, judge of the district court of the ninth (9th) judicial district.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
