

CHAPTER 164.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR ERECTING ADDITIONAL BUILDINGS FOR THE USE OF THE SCHOOL FOR THE BLIND AND THE SCHOOL FOR IDIOTS AND IMBECILES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

\$60,000 appropriated for buildings at Faribault.

SECTION 1. That the sum of sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated to be expended in the erection of additional buildings for the use of the school for the blind and the school for idiots and imbeciles at Faribault, and for heating, lighting and furnishing the same. The same to be paid upon warrants drawn by the president and countersigned by the secretary of the board of directors of the Minnesota institute for the deaf and dumb and the blind, and that on the presentation of such warrants to the State Auditor, it shall be his duty to draw warrants on the State Treasurer, for like amounts. Such money to be expended under the directions of said board of directors. *Provided*, That the warrants of the State Auditor on the State Treasurer for forty-five thousand dollars (\$45,000) of this appropriation, shall not be drawn during the year eighteen hundred and eighty-three (1883).

Only \$15,000 available for 1883.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 165.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO MEET EXPENSES OF THE STATE BOARD OF HEALTH, ARISING FROM EPIDEMICS OCCASIONED BY SMALL POX OR OTHER CONTAGIOUS DISEASES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Five thousand dollars appropriated for small pox expenses.

SECTION 1. That the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury, not otherwise appropriated for the purpose of meeting and paying the expenses
