The justice to whom such complaint is made shall forthwith issue a warrant directed to the sheriff or any constable of the county, requiring him to arrest such delinquent and bring him before such justice to be dealt with according to law, and upon such complaint and warrant further proceedings shall be had as is provided for the trial and punishment of misdemeanors.”

SEC. 3. That section number twenty-two (22) of said chapter number thirteen (13), be, and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows :

“SEC. 22. All fines imposed by the terms of section number nineteen (19), of this chapter shall, when collected, be paid to the overseer who entered complaint, to be by him expended in improving the roads and bridges in his district.”

SEC. 4. Section number twenty-three (23) of said chapter number thirteen (13) is hereby repealed.

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 30.

AN ACT TO AMEND AN ACT ENTITLED “AN ACT CONCERNING INN AND HOTEL KEEPERS AND LANDLORDS, AND FOR THE PROTECTION OF THEIR GUESTS,” BEING CHAPTER FIFTY-TWO (52) OF THE LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND AND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FOUR (1874).

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section two (2) of chapter fifty-two (52) of the General Laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-four (1874), being an act entitled “an act concerning inn and hotel keepers and landlords, and for the protection of their guests, approved March fifth (5th), one thousand eight hundred and seventy-four (1874), be amended by striking out the proviso thereof.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
