

CHAPTER 155.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE AN INCREASE OF THE SEWERAGE FUND IN THE CITY OF SAINT PAUL.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota.

SECTION 1. That the common council of the city of Saint Paul is hereby authorized and empowered to issue bonds to an amount not exceeding one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000), for the purpose of increasing the sewerage fund authorized by section seven (7) of chapter seven (7), of title two (2), of an act to reduce the law incorporating the city of Saint Paul, in the county of Ramsey, and state of Minnesota, and the several acts amendatory thereof, and certain other acts relating to said city, into one (1) act and to amend the same, approved March fifth (5th), one thousand eight hundred and seventy-four (1874). Said bonds shall be issued in such denominations as the common council may direct, and shall bear interest at a rate not to exceed six (6) per cent. per annum, and shall be redeemable in not less than twenty (20) years from the date thereof.

SEC. 2. This act to be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 156.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HENNEPIN COUNTY, MINNESOTA, TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$10,000) TO AID IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF A FREE WAGON IRON BRIDGE ACROSS THE MISSISSIPPI RIVER BETWEEN THE CITY OF ANOKA AND THE TOWN OF CHAMPLIN, MINNESOTA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That whenever the county of Anoka shall determine to construct a new, free wagon iron bridge, over the Mississippi river between the city of Anoka, state of Minnesota, and the town of Champlin, in said Hennepin county, pursuant to the provisions of chapter No. two hundred and sixty-two (262), of the special laws of Minnesota, for the year A. D. one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one (1881), and shall enter upon the construction of the
