

thereof, and make report of such cost to the state auditor. Any two (2) of said committee may act in the premises and in case two (2) of said committee cannot be found or refuse to act, it is hereby made the duty of the county auditor of said county of Douglass, to fill any vacancy by appointment, that may exist in said committee.

SEC. 4. That upon receipt of said report by the state auditor, he shall on demand of the board of supervisors of the said town of Urness, draw his order or orders in favor of said board of supervisors, on the state treasurer for moneys belonging to said fund, for the expense of building said bridges, not to exceed the sum of two hundred dollars (\$200) for each, or four hundred dollars (\$400) in the aggregate, and the said town supervisors shall upon receipt of the money, at once make the proper disbursement of the same.

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 182.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO BUILD A BRIDGE ACROSS THE CEDAR RIVER IN THE COUNTY OF MOWER.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of four hundred dollars (\$400) is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury belonging to the internal improvement fund, or out of the first moneys which shall come into the treasury belonging to said fund, not already appropriated, to aid the township and city of Austin, in the county of Mower, in re-building the wagon bridge across the Cedar river between the aforesaid township and city of Austin, on the territorial road on section two (2), town one hundred and two (102), range eighteen (18).

SEC. 2. This act shall be in full force from and after its passage.
