

CHAPTER 191.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO OPEN A STATE ROAD AND TO BUILD BRIDGES ON THE SAME, IN THE COUNTY OF CARVER.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500) is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury belonging to the internal improvement fund, or out of the first (1st) which shall come into the treasury belonging to said fund not otherwise appropriated, to aid in opening and bridging a state road laid out by authority of an act of the legislature, approved March fourth (4th), one thousand eight hundred and seventy-two (1872), located between the village of Rockford, in the county of Wright, and the village of Watertown, in the county of Carver.

SEC. 2. The said sum appropriated as above, shall be expended under the direction of the supervisors of the town of Watertown, Carver county.

SEC. 3. The moneys hereby appropriated shall be paid to the treasurer of the town of Watertown, upon the warrant of the state auditor, which shall be issued upon the application of the board of supervisors of said town, with their certificate that said bridge is completed and open for travel.

SEC. 4 This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 192.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO AID IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF A BRIDGE ACROSS BUFFALO CREEK, IN McLEOD COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of six hundred dollars (\$600), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury belonging to the internal improvement fund, or out of the first (1st) moneys which shall come into treasury belonging to said fund not already appropriated, for the purpose of assisting in building a substantial bridge across Buffalo Creek, in McLeod county, on the state road from Glencoe to Faxon, where said road crosses
