

## CHAPTER 268.

## AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE DRAINING OF A CERTAIN LAKE IN DOUGLAS COUNTY.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That William Thompson, Milo Meeker and such other persons as may associate with them, are hereby authorized to drain a certain lake in the town of Evansville, Douglas county, situate near the section corner of sections ten (10), eleven (11) and fifteen (15), township one hundred and twenty-nine (129), of range forty (40).

SEC. 2. That in order to carry out the provisions of this act, the consent of the persons owning land around said lake shall be obtained in writing, and filed in the office of the register of deeds of Douglas county.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 269.

## AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CLERK OF THE DISTRICT COURT OF THE COUNTY OF HENNEPIN TO TRANSCRIBE CERTAIN RECORDS IN HIS OFFICE.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the clerk of the district court for the county of Hennepin, in this state, is hereby authorized at the expense of said Hennepin county, to procure suitable books, the forms thereof to be approved by the judges of said court, for the transcribing of the docket entries of all judgments docketed in said court and now remaining in full force and unsatisfied. And the said clerk shall, before the first (1st) day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty-three (1883), transcribe such judgment docket entries into the books or book so procured as aforesaid, and when so transcribed, such transcribed record shall have the same force and effect in all respects, whether as evidence or otherwise as the original record thereof.

SEC. 2. That said clerk shall, at the expense of said Hennepin county, procure suitable books, the forms thereof to be approved by
