

CHAPTER 296.

AN ACT FOR THE PROTECTION OF FISH IN DIAMOND LAKE,
KANDIYOHI COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota.

SECTION 1. [That] it shall be unlawful for any person to catch fish in Diamond Lake, Kandiyohi county, in any way or manner whatever save as hereinafter stated.

SEC. 2. All persons may fish in said lake with hook and line, spear or shooting with gun.

SEC. 3. Any person or persons violating the provision of this act shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof before court having competent jurisdiction, shall be fined not less than five dollars (\$5) or more than one hundred dollars (\$100), or imprisonment in the county jail not exceeding one (1) month, or both such fine and imprisonment.

SEC. 4. The fines collected under the provision of this chapter shall be paid into the county treasury of Kandiyohi county for the use of the common schools.

SEC. 5. All acts and part of acts conflicting with this act, are hereby repealed.

SEC. 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 297.

AN ACT TO CONFIRM A CERTAIN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF
SAINT PAUL, RELATING TO THE SAINT PAUL CITY RAILWAY
COMPANY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That a certain ordinance numbered two hundred and sixty-eight (268) of the city of Saint Paul, entitled An ordinance relating to street railways in the city of Saint Paul, approved February eighth (8th), one thousand eight hundred and eighty-two (1882), be and the same is hereby confirmed and validated.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
