

CHAPTER 320.

AN ACT TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE RED WING WAGON AND CARRIAGE MANUFACTURING COMPANY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the name of the corporation known as the Red Wing Wagon and Carriage Manufacturing Company, be and the same is hereby changed to that of the Red Wing Wagon Company.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 321.

AN ACT TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE CERTAIN RELIGIOUS CORPORATION KNOWN AS AND INCORPORATED UNDER THE NAME OF THE NORWEGIAN AND DANISH METHODIST EPISCOPAL CHURCH OF MINNEAPOLIS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the name of "The Norwegian and Danish Methodist Episcopal Church of Minneapolis," a religious corporation of the city of Minneapolis, Hennepin county, Minnesota, by which name said corporation was on the twenty-seventh (27th) day of May, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-two (1882), duly incorporated under the laws of this state, be and the same hereby is changed and is hereby named and designated "The Norwegian Methodist Episcopal Church of Minneapolis," and that said corporation stand incorporated under the name of "The Norwegian Methodist Episcopal Church of Minneapolis," by which name it was formerly known, and by which name said religious body formerly acquired and now holds certain real estate in the city of Minneapolis, in the county of Hennepin, Minnesota.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
