

CHAPTER 54.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION ONE (1) OF AN ACT ENTITLED AN ACT TO AMEND AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY OF RAMSEY AND THE CITY OF SAINT PAUL TO ISSUE BONDS TO BUILD AN ALMS HOUSE AND HOSPITAL, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES, APPROVED FEBRUARY TWENTY-NINTH (29th), ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO (1872), AND THE ACT SUPPLEMENTAL AND AMENDATORY THEREOF, APPROVED MARCH SIXTH (6th), ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SIX (1876).

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section one (1) of said act is hereby amended so as to read as follows, viz:

That the judges of the district court of the second (2d) judicial district, county of Ramsey, state of Minnesota, or a majority of them, are hereby authorized and empowered at any time they may deem proper, to appoint three (3) directors, citizens and free holders of said county of Ramsey, who shall constitute the board of control of said county, and each shall hold his appointment at the pleasure of the authority appointing them. *Provided*, however, that the board of control, as organized on the first (1st) day of January, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-three (1883), shall hold without any further appointment during the pleasure of said judges, and shall receive as compensation three dollars (\$3) per day for the time actually employed in his official duties, provided such compensation in any one (1) year shall not exceed the sum of three hundred dollars (\$300) each.

Said board of control shall have the power to appoint a clerk whose compensation shall be, and remain as is now provided by law. No member of the city council or of the board of county commissioners shall hereafter be elected a member or clerk of said board of control.

SEC. 2. That all acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of the above and foregoing are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
