

CHAPTER 70.

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER THREE HUNDRED AND SIXTY-FOUR (364), OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE (1881), RELATING TO A FERRY AT SAINT VINCENT.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section two (2), of chapter three hundred and sixty-four (364), of the special laws of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one (1881), is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Section 2. That hereafter the board of trustees of the village of St. Vincent shall have the power, and they are hereby authorized to license, regulate and control the said ferry under the general laws of this state.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 71.

AN ACT TO AMEND AN ACT ENTITLED "AN ACT TO PRESCRIBE THE SESSIONS OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF STEARNS COUNTY," BEING CHAPTER THREE HUNDRED AND FIFTY-FOUR (354), OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE (1881).

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section one (1), of chapter three hundred and fifty-four (354), of the special laws of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one (1881), be amended so as to read as follows: The board of county commissioners of Stearns county shall meet for the purpose of transacting such business as may devolve upon or be brought before it in addition to all regular sessions now prescribed by law, on the second Tuesday of May and of September, and on the third Tuesday of December in each year, but none of said regular sessions shall continue for more than three (3) days.

SEC. 2. That section three (3), of said chapter three hundred and fifty-four (354), is hereby amended so as to read as follows: No commissioner of said county shall receive pay for more than forty-five (45)
