

CHAPTER 78.

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER EIGHTY-SIX (86) OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF A. D. ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE (1873), ENTITLED "AN ACT FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A PHONOGRAPHIC REPORTER FOR THE DISTRICT COURT AND COURT OF COMMON PLEAS OF RAMSEY COUNTY, AND TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SAID COUNTY TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT OF SUCH PHONOGRAPHER," APPROVED MARCH TEN (10), A. D. ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE (1873).

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota.

SECTION 1. Section one (1) of chapter eighty-six (86) of the special laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-three (1873), an act entitled "An act for the appointment of a phonographic reporter for the district court and court of common pleas of Ramsey county, and to authorize the county commissioners of said county to provide for the payment of such phonographer," approved March ten (10), A. D. one thousand eight hundred and seventy-three (1873), is hereby amended by striking out the words "fifteen hundred dollars (\$1,500 per annum," where the same occur in said section, and inserting in lieu thereof the words "three thousand five hundred dollars (\$3,500 per annum."

SEC. 2. In addition to the duties now imposed on said reporter by the act of which this is amendatory, the said reporter shall take full phonographic notes of all trials and proceedings in the district court of Ramsey county before any of the judges of said court in both court and jury cases; and it shall be the duty of said reporter, when more than one (1) of said judges shall be sitting at the same time, to provide such additional phonographic force, at his own expense, and with the approval of the court, as may be necessary to report any cause so being heard by said judges; and it shall be the duty of such reporter to always have an assistant phonographer to make any transcript of any of his minutes immediately when the same may be ordered. The transcript fee paid said reporter shall be at the rate of ten (10) cents per folio, and such transcript fee so paid by any party to an action shall be included in the taxable disbursements of the suit.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
