## CHAPTER 107.

*An act to legalize the action of any village council in this state which has heretofore made or agreed to make an appropriation out of the village funds in aid of building any bridge located outside of the corporate limits of such village.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Legalizing  
appropriation  
of village  
funds.

SECTION 1. That in all cases where any village council in this state has heretofore made or agreed to make an appropriation out of the village funds in aid of building any bridge, which said bridge is located outside of the corporate limits of said village, and where said amount so appropriated has been in an amount not to exceed the sum of five hundred (\$500) dollars, the action of said village council in all such cases is hereby legalized.

SEC. 2. This act shall not affect any action now pending.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 108.

Law  
libraries.

*An act for the benefit and maintenance of certain law libraries in counties of two hundred and twenty-five thousand inhabitants or more.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Counties two  
hundred  
twenty-five  
thousand  
or more.

SECTION 1. That all balances of any deposits made with the clerk of any district court as security for the fees of such clerk in any action or proceeding pending therein, in counties of two hundred and twenty-five thousand inhabitants or more, after the termination of such action or proceeding and which has not been or shall not be repaid or returned to the party to such action or proceeding depositing the same, or in compliance with his order directing the disposition thereof within three years after the termination of such action or proceeding, shall become and be the property of any bar association or any individual or corporation, if any such there be.
