

## CHAPTER 83.

H. F. No. 329.

*An act entitled an act accepting a grant by congress to the State of Minnesota of certain lands for forestry purposes.*

Accepting  
land grant.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the State of Minnesota hereby accepts the grant by congress of twenty thousand (20,000) acres of vacant public land within said state for forestry purposes made by an act of congress approved April twenty-eight (28), nineteen hundred and four (1904).

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 84.

H. F. No. 330

*An act entitled "an act to authorize county auditors in this state to give certain public notices and do certain things as are provided for in chapter 258, in the Laws of Minnesota for the year 1901, and as amended by chapter 38 in the Laws of Minnesota for 1902, pertaining to drainage."*

Drainage.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That in all cases in this state where proceedings have been had or attempted under chapter 258 of the Laws of Minnesota for 1901, as amended by chapter 38 of the Laws of Minnesota for the year 1902, and acts amendatory thereof, for the establishment of county drains, and the notices of the pendency of the petition and all other notices and proceedings in such matter, including the filing of the order of the board of county commissioners establishing such ditch and confirming the report of the viewers, as provided for in section 9, chapter 258, the Laws of Minnesota for 1901, and acts amendatory thereof, have all been given and had, and when no appeal has been taken from said order, and the contracts for the digging of such ditch have not been let, the county auditor of the county in which such proceed-
