

CHAPTER 97.

H. F. No. 465.

An act to amend section fifteen (15) of chapter two hundred and ninety (290) of the General Laws of nineteen hundred three (1903), relating to the appropriation of money out of the internal improvement fund, to aid in building a road, bridges and culverts in Cass county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section fifteen (15) of chapter two hundred and ninety (290) of the General Laws of nineteen hundred three (1903), be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Section 15. That the sum of eight hundred dollars (\$800.00) is hereby appropriated out of said fund to be used and expended in opening up, building and repairing the county road now laid out and running south from the village of Walker, through township one hundred and forty-two (142), range thirty-one (31) and township one hundred and forty-one (141), ranges thirty (30) and thirty-one (31), in Cass county, which said road is known as the Walker-Lothrop road; and for the construction of bridges and culverts on said road. Said money shall be expended under the supervision of the board of county commissioners of said county.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 98.

H. F. No. 360.

An act to authorize town clerks to hold their office in certain villages.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The town clerk of any town in this state may hold his office in any village, the territory of which said village shall have been, prior to the incorporation thereof, a part of and included within the boundaries of such town.
