

chase of four hundred and eighty (480) acres of Indian allotments located in or adjacent to said land, or so much thereof as may be found desirable, all to be expended by said board of regents for the purpose herein stated, provided that no portion of this appropriation shall be available until the tract of land, amounting to not less than 2,200 acres, shall have been given to the state free of all costs or charges whatsoever and subject only to the conditions hereinbefore recited.

CHAPTER 132—H. F. No. 373.

An act to amend Section 1 of Chapter 229, of the General Laws of Minnesota for 1907, relating to the compensation of senators and representatives of the legislature of the State of Minnesota and its presiding officers.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

Legislative members to receive final payment on last day of session.—Section 1. That section 1 of chapter 229 of the General Laws of Minnesota for 1907 be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

“Section 1. The compensation of members of the house of representatives of the legislature of the state of Minnesota shall be one thousand dollars for the entire term to which they are elected, payable as follows: two hundred fifty dollars on the first day of February, two hundred fifty dollars on the fifteenth day of March of the year in which the regular legislative session is held, and five hundred dollars on the last day of the regular legislative session: the compensation of senators of the legislature shall be two thousand dollars for the entire term to which they are elected, payable as follows: two hundred fifty dollars on the first day of February, two hundred fifty dollars on the fifteenth day of March of each year in which a regular legislative session is held, and five hundred dollars on the last day of such regular legislative session.”
