

CHAPTER 84—S. F. No. 451

An act relating to the payment of retirement allowances to employees of cities of the first class; repealing Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 422.01, Subdivisions 23 and 30.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

[422.01] **Definitions.** Section 1. **Repeal.** That Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 422.01, Subdivisions 23 and 30, are hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 85—S. F. No. 452

An act relating to the payment of retirement allowances to employees of cities of the first class; amending Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 422.05.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 422.05, is hereby amended to read as follows:

422.05. Classification of employees. Employees of the city shall be divided into a contributing class, a non-contributing class, and an exempt class.

The contributing class shall consist of all employees not included in either of the other two classes, and shall be subdivided into present encumbents, employees in the service of the city at the date sections 422.01 to 422.23 becomes effective therein, who elect to become contributors to and prospective beneficiaries of the fund created by sections 422.01 to 422.23, and future entrants, employees who enter the service of the city subsequent to the date sections 422.01 to 422.23 becomes effective therein.

Any employee in the service of any public corporation now or hereafter created in and for any two or more contiguous cities, the funds of which public corporation are in whole or in part raised by taxation on the property in such cities, may become a member of the contributing class by giving a written notice to the retirement board of his acceptance of and his desire to avail himself of the provisions of
