

examiners showing fitness. Fees for journeymen shall be \$5.00 for examination and \$2.00 for renewal, and for contracting steamfitters \$20 for examination and \$15 for renewal. Licenses shall expire December thirty-first, but may be renewed upon application made the following January or February; but, if in February, only upon payment of an additional fee of \$1.00 for a journeyman and \$5.00 for a contracting steamfitter.

The commission may issue temporary revocable permits pending examination, and, to assist in this, may appoint agents, without compensation, and may authorize one of its examiners or high pressure steam inspectors to hold a special permit examination, the results to be reported in writing.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect from and after July 1, 1951.

CHAPTER 120—H. F. No. 416

An act relating to limitations on county road and bridge tax levy; repealing Laws 1947, Chapter 434, Section 2, and Laws 1949, Chapter 188, Section 2.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Laws 1947, Chapter 434, Section 2, is hereby repealed.

Sec. 2. Laws 1949, Chapter 188, Section 2, is hereby repealed.
