CHAPTER 126—S. F. No. 519

An act relating to the Village of Fosston Fire Department Relief Association, authorizing payment of certain pensions at an earlier date.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Fosston, fire department pensions. fire department relief association of the village of Fosston may pay out of any funds received from the state, or other source, a service pension in such amount, not exceeding \$40 per month, as hereinafter authorized, or as may be provided by its bylaws, to each of its members who has heretofore retired or may hereafter retire, who has reached or shall hereafter reach the age of 50 years and who has done or hereafter shall do active duty for 20 years or more as a member of a volunteer, paid or partially paid and partially volunteer, fire department in the municipality where the association exists, and who has been or shall hereafter be a member of such fire department relief association at least three years prior to such retirement and who complies with such additional conditions as to age, service, and membership as may be prescribed by the certificate or by-laws of the association.

The amount of monthly pension which may be paid to such retired fireman may be increased by adding to the maximum above prescribed an amount not exceeding \$2 per month for each year of active duty over 20 years of service before retirement; provided, that no such fire department relief association shall pay to any member thereof a pension in any greater amount than the sum of \$60 per month.

Any such fire department relief association where the majority of its members are volunteer firemen may provide in its certificate of incorporation or by-laws for a service pension in an amount not exceeding \$300 per year of service to be paid in a lump sum where the retiring member qualifies for a service pension under the provisions hereinbefore set forth.

These pensions shall be uniform in amount, except as herein otherwise provided. No such pension shall be paid to any person while he remains a member of the fire department and no person receiving such pension shall be entitled to other relief from the association. No payments made or to be made by the association to any member on the pension role shall be subject to judgment, garnishment, execution, or other legal process and no person entitled to such payment shall have the right to assign the same, nor shall the association have the authority to recognize any assignment or pay over any sum which has been assigned.

Sec. 2. Section 1 shall be effective upon its approval by the village council of the village of Fosston.

CHAPTER 127-S. F. No. 587

An act relating to terms of district court in certain counties; amending Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 484.13.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 484.13, is amended to read:

484.13 Certain counties in third judicial district. General terms of district court in the counties named in this section shall be held each year at the times herein specified:

Dodge County: The first Monday in April and the third Monday in September.

Rice County: The first Monday in May and the first Wednesday after the first Monday in November.

Steele County: The first Monday in April and the third Monday in September.

Waseca County: The first Monday in March and the second Monday in October.

Where any general term in any of said counties has been or shall hereafter be adjourned for a period of more than 30 days, and issues of fact in any action are joined more than eight days before the first day of any such adjourned term, then, and in that case, such action may be brought on for trial at such adjourned term upon notice of trial served eight days or more before the beginning of said adjourned term.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect on July 1, 1959.
