

CHAPTER 176—S. F. No. 807

An act relating to the area description of the Nemadji State Forest.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. The area description of the Nemadji State Forest is described as follows:

17. **Nemadji State Forest.** Fractional townships 44, 45, and 46, range 15; the south one-third of fractional township 47, range 15; sections 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, and 9, township 43, range 16; townships 44, 45, and 46, range 16, except the north half of the northeast quarter of the northwest quarter section 16, township 46, range 16; the south one-third of township 47, range 16; sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 9, 10, 11, and 12 of township 43, range 17; sections 1, 2, 11, 12, 13, 14, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 32, 33, 34, 35, and 36, township 44, range 17; the east one-third of township 45, range 17; township 46, range 17, except the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter, and the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter of section 16, township 46, range 17; all west of the 4th principal meridian.

Sec. 2. The area description in section 1 hereof is substituted for the area description of Nemadji State Forest as contained in Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 89.021, enumeration number 17, and the revisor of statutes in compiling the Minnesota Statutes shall substitute the area description in section 1 for that description contained in said section 89.021, enumeration number 17.

CHAPTER 177—S. F. No. 906

An act authorizing the conveyance of certain real estate owned by the state to Independent School District No. 623, Ramsey County.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **State real estate, transfer.** The governor, upon the recommendation of the commissioner of administration, shall transfer and convey by quitclaim deed, in such form as the attorney general may approve, in the name of

the state of Minnesota, to Independent School District No. 623, Ramsey County, for public purposes, upon such terms and conditions agreed upon, the following described property located in Ramsey County, Minnesota, to-wit:

All of Lot Three (3) and that portion of Lot Four (4), Cope's Subdivision of Lot One (1) of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Eleven (11), Township Twenty-nine (29) North, Range Twenty-three (23) West;

which lies southerly of a line run parallel with and distant 175 feet southwesterly of the following described line:

Beginning at a point on the North and South Quarter line of said Section Eleven (11), distant 1214.1 feet south of the center of said Section Eleven (11); thence run southeasterly at an angle of 81° 12' with said North and South Quarter line for 2300 feet and there terminating; containing 7.0 acres, more or less.

Subject to the restriction of access, or the right of ingress to or egress from said property to Highway No. 118, marked No. 36, as determined by the commissioner of highways.

Sec. 2. Such deed shall be conditioned upon the continued use of said property for public purposes, and upon discontinuance for such use, the title to said property shall revert to the state of Minnesota.

CHAPTER 178—H. F. No. 424

An act relating to motor vehicles defining special mobile equipment and exempting such equipment from taxation as motor vehicles; amending Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 168.011 and Section 168.012, Subdivision 3 and 5.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 168.011, is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:

Subd. 22. Special mobile equipment. Special mobile equipment means every vehicle not designed or used primarily for the transportation of persons or property and only incidentally operated or moved over a highway, including but
