

other peace officer within the scope of the rules or regulations of his appointive or elected agency or office, any such assistance shall be within the line of duty and course of employment of the officer rendering the assistance.

Subd. 3. For the purposes of this section the term "peace officer" means any member of a police department, highway patrol, game warden service, sheriff's office, or any other law enforcement agency, the members of which have, by law, the power of arrest.

Subd. 4. This section shall in no way be construed as extending or enlarging the duties or authority of any peace officer or any other law enforcement agent as defined in subdivision 3 except as provided in this section.

CHAPTER 375—H. F. No. 1323

*An act to authorize Wright County to appropriate money for nursing homes or homes for the aged.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Wright County, nursing home.** The board of county commissioners of Wright county may appropriate a sum not to exceed \$15,000 to aid in the acquisition of lands for a nursing home or home for the aged or for the purpose of the erection, construction, improvement, alterations, equipment, and maintenance of such nursing home or home for the aged within such county and they may appropriate and pay the same to aid a nonprofit corporation to acquire such lands, erect, construct, improve, alter, equip, and maintain a nursing home or home for the aged within such county.

Sec. 2. The county board may levy a tax not to exceed said sum of \$15,000 for the purpose of accomplishing the provisions of section 1.

Sec. 3. The authority granted by the provisions of this act shall be in addition to all now existing or hereafter authorized for expenditures on the part of such county.

Sec. 4. This act takes effect when approved by a majority of the county board of Wright county.
