

## CHAPTER 398—H. F. No. 1798

[Coded]

*An act relating to franchised dealers in agricultural machinery or implements.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. [325.63] **Agricultural implement dealerships; return of stock.** If a franchised agricultural machinery or implement dealership is discontinued for economic reasons, the firm, company, or person issuing the franchise to the dealer shall purchase all listed parts in the dealer's stock purchased originally from firm, company or person issuing franchise at a price agreeable to the franchised dealer and such firm, company, or person.

## CHAPTER 399—H. F. No. 992

*An act relating to the hospital commission of the City of Virginia in the County of St. Louis; authorizing a depreciation reserve, expenditures therefrom, and charges therefor.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Hospital depreciation.** The hospital commission of the city of Virginia in the county of St. Louis may establish and maintain under its control a depreciation reserve for the purpose of providing repairs to and replacements of its hospital facilities and equipment. The commission may from time to time expend sums in the depreciation reserve for such repair and replacement. In determining the charges to be imposed by the hospital it may give consideration to and may include the amount necessary to create an adequate depreciation reserve.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective only after its approval by a majority of the governing body of the city of Virginia.
