CHAPTER 505—S. F. No. 433

*An act relating to rights of condemnation by the city of Thief River Falls for off-road parking and historic markers.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Historic marker.** The city of Thief River Falls is authorized to acquire by purchase, gift, or condemnation, private property within or without the corporate limits of the city for the purpose of a roadside parking area and site for an historic marker and to establish, construct, operate and maintain such parking area and site, and erect and maintain thereon an historic marker.

Sec. 2. The governing body of said city may, by resolution duly adopted, convey any and all of the property so acquired to the State of Minnesota or to the Minnesota Department of Highways upon the agreement of the state or said highway department to provide adequate and proper off-road parking, an historic marker, rustic guard rails and rustic markers on and approaching said property.

Sec. 3. This act shall become effective only after it is approved by a majority of the governing body of the city of Thief River Falls.
