

shall be \$5. Upon being notified that he has successfully passed the examination for original license the applicant shall submit an application, with the license fee herein provided. Annual license fees shall be \$5 for journeymen and \$25 for master plumbers but persons qualifying for license after June 30 of any year shall be issued a license for the remainder of the calendar year upon payment of one-half of the annual fee. Licenses shall expire December 31st, but may be renewed upon application made the following January or February, but if in February only upon payment of an additional fee of \$1 for a journeyman and \$5 for a master plumber.

CHAPTER 79—S. F. No. 134

An act relating to the salaries of the County Commissioners of Dakota County.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Dakota County, commissioners salaries.** In the county of Dakota the yearly salaries of the members of the board of county commissioners shall be set by said board at a sum not to exceed \$3,600, which sum shall be payable in equal monthly installments.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective only after its approval by a majority vote of the board of county commissioners of Dakota County.
