CHAPTER 197—H. F. No. 782

An act relating to counties; authorizing the creation and maintenance of sheriffs' contingent funds.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. [387.212] **Sheriffs; contingent fund.** The board of county commissioners in any county may create a sheriff's contingent fund and may credit thereto not more than \$1,000. The moneys in such fund may be used for the advancement and reimbursement of expenses of the sheriff and his office. Such moneys shall be disbursed by the county treasurer in accordance with rules and regulations prescribed by the board.

CHAPTER 198—H. F. No. 1300

An act relating to the city of Winona; providing for the appointment of the city treasurer by the city council.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Winona, city of; treasurer; appointment.** Notwithstanding the provisions of any other law to the contrary, the treasurer of the city of Winona shall be appointed by the city council by vote of a majority of all of its members on the third Monday of April in each year for a term of one year commencing May 1, provided that the person who is treasurer on the date this act becomes effective shall continue in office for the remainder of the term to which he was elected or appointed and until his successor is appointed and qualifies, subject to any power of removal vested in the city council by other law.
