An act relating to the county of Anoka; removing the ceiling upon the salaries payable to certain county officers; amending Laws 1959, Chapter 199, Section 2, as amended.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Laws 1959, Chapter 199, Section 2, as amended by Laws 1961, Chapter 366, Section 2, is amended to read:

Sec. 2. **Anoka county; county officers, salaries.** The county shall pay to each official designated in section 1 of this act a salary to be determined by the county board by resolution, which salary shall not be less than \$9,000 per annum in any case and shall not exceed \$13,500 per annum in any case.

Sec. 2. *This act shall be effective upon its approval by the governing body of Anoka county and upon compliance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.*
