

These pensions shall be uniform in amount, except as herein otherwise provided. No such pension shall be paid to any person while he remains a member of the fire department and no person receiving such pension shall be entitled to other relief from the association. No payments made or to be made by the association to any member on the pension roll shall be subject to judgment, garnishment, execution, or other legal process and no person entitled to such payment shall have the right to assign the same, nor shall the association have the authority to recognize any assignment or pay over any sum which has been assigned.

Sec. 2. This law shall become effective upon its approval by the governing body of the village of Hoyt Lakes and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021. This act shall expire January 1, 1973.

CHAPTER 860—H. F. No. 1253

An act relating to salaries of members of the county board of commissioners of Itasca county; amending Laws 1959, Chapter 352, Section 1, as amended.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Laws 1959, Chapter 352, Section 1, as amended by Laws 1961, Chapter 356, Section 1, is amended to read:

Section 1. **Itasca county, commissioners' salaries.** *Subdivision 1.* Notwithstanding the provisions of any other law to the contrary, each member, except the chairman, of the board of county commissioners of the county of Itasca shall receive a monthly salary of \$400 payable on the first day of each calendar month as the salaries of other county officials are paid. The chairman of the board of county commissioners shall receive a monthly salary of \$425 payable in the same manner as other board members' salaries are paid.

Subd. 2. *The salaries specified in subdivision 1 constitute base salaries. The county board, if it so elects, may increase these salaries on the basis of the cost of living salary adjustment as provided in Minnesota Statutes, Section 375.43.*

Sec. 2. *Section 1 is effective when approved by the board of county commissioners of Itasca county and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.*

CHAPTER 861—H. F. No. 1290

An act relating to Hennepin county; abolishing the board of auditors in Hennepin county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Hennepin county; board of auditors.** The board of audit in Hennepin county is abolished and the duties of the board of audit in Hennepin county are transferred to the county board of commissioners except that the three audits of the treasurer's records required annually under the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 385.06 shall not be mandatory. The county board shall employ the assistance of any county officer or employee or any certified public accountant in the performance of duties hereby transferred to the county board where such assistance is deemed necessary by the county board to accomplish the internal audit or other functions involved.

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon its approval by the board of county commissioners of Hennepin county and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 645.021.

CHAPTER 862—H. F. No. 1356

An act authorizing the commissioner of conservation to mark canoe and boating routes and develop camp sites on certain rivers; amending Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 85.32, Subdivisions 1, 2 and 3.
