

and all connections thereto, according to a schedule calculated by the board to be sufficient to pay all current, reasonable, and necessary costs of the operation and maintenance of the facilities and to produce net revenues which, with the collections of such special assessments from time to time, will exceed by at least five percent the amounts needed to meet when due the principal and interest payments on the bonds, and shall irrevocably appropriate all collections of such assessments and revenues to the bond sinking fund. All bonds herein authorized shall be issued, sold, and secured otherwise as provided in Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 475.

Sec. 4. This act takes effect with respect to each of the counties of Chisago, Mille Lacs, Sherburne, and Isanti when approved by each of their respective boards of county commissioners and upon compliance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.

CHAPTER 420—H.F.No.1612

An act relating to towns; office of member of town board of supervisors not incompatible with office of member of school board.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. [367.033] **TOWNS; OFFICERS; SERVICE ON SCHOOL BOARDS; INCOMPATIBILITY OF OFFICES.** Notwithstanding any statute or other law to the contrary, any person may serve on both the school board, however organized, and the town board of supervisors concurrently. This act does not apply to members of town board of any town exercising the powers of a village under Minnesota Statutes, Section 368.01, or any special law.
