

Subd. 2. ANNUAL FEE CHANGE AUTHORIZED, Beginning August 1, 1983, and annually after that, the chief judge of the judicial district may by order establish new transcript fee ceilings per folio.

CHAPTER 104 — H.F.No. 903

An act relating to insurance; removing obsolete statutory provisions regulating assessment benefit associations; repealing Minnesota Statutes 1982, sections 63.01 to 63.35.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. REPEALER.

Minnesota Statutes 1982, sections 63.01; 63.011; 63.02; 63.03; 63.04; 63.05; 63.06; 63.07; 63.08; 63.09; 63.10; 63.11; 63.12; 63.13; 63.14; 63.15; 63.16; 63.17; 63.18; 63.19; 63.20; 63.21; 63.22; 63.23; 63.235; 63.24; 63.25; 63.26; 63.27; 63.28; 63.29; 63.30; 63.31; 63.32; 63.33; 63.34; and 63.35, are repealed.

CHAPTER 105 — H.F.No. 953

An act relating to the city of Silver Bay; authorizing the establishment of detached banking facilities.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. CITY OF SILVER BAY; DETACHED BANKING FACILITIES.

With the prior approval of the commissioner of banks, any bank doing business within 35 miles of the city of Silver Bay may establish and maintain not more than one detached facility in the city of Silver Bay by merger with, or acquisition of, an existing bank in the city of Silver Bay. Any bank desiring to establish a detached facility shall follow the approval procedure prescribed in Minnesota Statutes, section 47.54. The establishment of a detached facility pursuant to this act is subject to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, sections 47.51 to 47.57 except insofar as inconsistent with this section.

Sec. 2. LOCAL APPROVAL.

This act takes effect the day after compliance by the governing body of the city of Silver Bay with Minnesota Statutes, section 645.021, subdivision 3.

CHAPTER 106 — H.F.No. 959

An act relating to commerce; authorizing certain retailers of motor vehicle fuel to compute sales by the half-gallon; proposing new law coded in Minnesota Statutes 1982, section 325E.095.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. [325E.095] COMPUTATION OF SALES BY SMALL RETAILERS.

A retail business selling less than 50,000 gallons of motor vehicle fuel per year may compute fuel pump sales by the half-gallon.

This section supersedes any contrary provision of law.

CHAPTER 107 — H.F.No. 1122

An act relating to the town of Flowing; permitting the town to conduct elections and town business in a nearby city.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. FLOWING TOWN BUSINESS.

The town of Flowing, in Clay county, may conduct town meetings, town board meetings, and any other town business in the city of Felton. The town may use the town hall as a polling place for all elections notwithstanding the requirements for the location of a polling place as provided in Minnesota Statutes, section 204B.16, subdivision 1.

Sec. 2. LOCAL APPROVAL.

This act is effective the day after compliance with Minnesota Statutes, section 645.021, subdivision 3, by the Flowing town board.
