

The city of Montevideo may exercise the same powers allowed to statutory cities by Minnesota Statutes, section 412.851.

This act is effective the day after compliance with Minnesota Statutes, section 645.021, subdivision 3, by the governing body of the city of Montevideo.

CHAPTER 79 — S.F.No. 322

An act relating to soil and water conservation districts; authorizing annual audits by certified public accountants; amending Minnesota Statutes 1982, section 40.06, subdivision 4.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1982, section 40.06, subdivision 4, is amended to read:

Subd. 4. **EMPLOYEE BONDS; AUDIT; REMOVAL OF SUPERVISOR.** The supervisors shall provide for the execution of surety bonds for all employees and officers who shall be entrusted with funds or property; shall provide for the keeping of a full and accurate record of all proceedings and of all resolutions, regulations, and orders issued or adopted; the state auditor shall annually audit the books of said soil and water conservation district and its supervisors, or, at the request of the board of supervisors, the state auditor may contract for an annual audit by a certified public accountant. The state auditor may determine that an annual audit of a soil and water conservation district is not necessary, in which case the audit shall be conducted at least every four years. Any supervisor may be removed by the state soil and water conservation board upon notice and hearing, for neglect of duty or malfeasance in office, but for no other reason.

CHAPTER 80 — S.F.No. 332

An act relating to financial institutions; banks; authorizing the leasing of personal property to employees, stockholders, directors, or officers; amending Minnesota Statutes 1982, section 48.152, subdivision 8; repealing Minnesota Statutes 1982, section 48.152, subdivision 9.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1982, section 48.152, subdivision 8, is amended to read:

Subd. 8. The total amount of unpaid rental obligations of a customer to a bank on personal property, shall constitute a liability of the customer within the meaning of section 48.24, ~~subdivision~~ subdivisions 1 and 4.

Sec. 2. **REPEALER.**

Minnesota Statutes 1982, section 48.152, subdivision 9, is repealed.

Sec. 3. **EFFECTIVE DATE.**

This act is effective the day after final enactment.

CHAPTER 81 — S.F.No. 372

An act relating to claims against the state; providing for payment of various claims; appropriating money.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. **CLAIMS; APPROPRIATIONS; GENERAL FUND.**

Subdivision 1. The sums set forth in this section are appropriated from the general fund to the persons named in this section in full and final payment of claims against the state. Except as otherwise provided, the appropriations in section 1 of this act are available until June 30, 1984.

Subd. 2. Arrowhead Regional Corrections, c/o Patrick Heaslip, Two Harbors Police Department Ticket No. 1333, 319 Courthouse, Duluth, Minnesota 55802, for medical expenses for an injury claimant received while doing court-ordered community service restitution.....\$165.25.

Subd. 3. Robert J. Bode, as guardian for Todd Bode, Box 85, Pillager, Minnesota 56473, for a portion of a personal injury damage award paid by the department of public welfare to his attorney for attorney's fees rather than to him for his injuries.....\$7,740.00.

Subd. 4. Ronald Croteau, Jr., 7525 4th Avenue, Circle Pines, Minnesota 56544, for an injury received while an inmate of Minnesota correctional facility- Lino Lakes, which resulted in a permanent partial disability of the loss of the distal phalanx of his left middle finger.....\$1,563.00.
