

Subd. 4. If a person other than George Chlebeczek purchases the land, the purchaser shall pay in cash to the state at the time of sale, in addition to all other required payments, the full amount for which the improvements are appraised. The amount so received by the state for the improvements shall be paid over by the state treasurer, with the approval of the commissioner of finance, to George Chlebeczek or his successor in interest as compensation therefor, and the moneys required for the payment are appropriated for this purpose.

Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.

Section 1 is effective the day following its final enactment.

CHAPTER 90 — H.F.No. 132

An act relating to state lands; authorizing the sale and conveyance of a certain tract of tax-forfeited land by Sherburne county.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. CONVEYANCE OF TAX-FORFEITED LAND IN SHERBURNE COUNTY.

Notwithstanding the provisions of section 282.018, or any other contrary provision of Minnesota Statutes, chapter 282, Sherburne county, with the approval of the commissioner of natural resources, may sell, at public or private sale, and at not less than the appraised value, a lakeshore lot described as: Lot 40, Block 1, Second Fremont Lake Shores Addition to the City of Zimmerman. The property shall be appraised as provided in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 282, and if sold at public sale, shall be sold and conveyed as provided in that chapter. If sold at private sale, the property shall be sold and conveyed as far as practicable as provided in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 282.

Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This act is effective the day following final enactment.
