An act relating to state government finance; providing deficiency funding for certain state agencies; appropriating money.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. SUMMARY OF APPROPRIATIONS.

The amount shown in this section summarizes direct appropriations, by fund, made in this act.
