The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Health and Human Services Policy

1.1 A bill for an act  
 1.2 relating to public safety; permitting terminally ill persons to possess small  
 1.3 amounts of marijuana without criminal penalty; proposing coding for new law in  
 1.4 Minnesota Statutes, chapter 152.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. [152.25] EXEMPTION FROM PROSECUTION; TERMINAL  
 1.7 ILLNESS.

1.8 Any person who has been diagnosed by a licensed doctor of medicine as being  
 1.9 terminally ill is not subject to prosecution under this chapter for possession of a small  
 1.10 amount of marijuana.
