1.1 A House concurrent resolution

1.2 relating to adjournment of the House of Representatives and Senate until the public

1.3 interest warrants reconvening.

1.4 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the State of Minnesota, the Senate

1.5 concurring:

1.6 1. Upon its adjournment on April 14, 2020, the House of Representatives and the Senate may

1.7 set its next day of meeting for April 28, 2020; may stand adjourned until the second day after

1.8 members of the House of Representatives and the Senate are notified to assemble pursuant to section

1.9 2; or may stand adjourned until the second day after members of the House of Representatives or

1.10 members of the Senate are notified to assemble pursuant to section 3. The speaker of the House of

1.11 Representatives and the majority leader of the Senate, respectively, may set the precise time of day

1.12 members shall reassemble under this section, section 2, or section 3.

1.13 2. The speaker of the House of Representatives and the majority leader of the Senate, acting

1.14 jointly after providing advance notice to the minority leader of the House of Representatives and

1.15 the minority leader of the Senate, shall notify the members of the House of Representatives and

1.16 Senate, respectively, to reassemble whenever the public interest, in the opinion of the speaker of

1.17 the House of Representatives and the majority leader in the Senate, warrants it.

1.18 3. The speaker of the House of Representatives, acting individually after providing advance

1.19 notice to the minority leader of the House of Representatives and the majority leader of the Senate,

1.20 or the majority leader of the Senate, acting individually after providing advance notice to the

1.21 minority leader of the Senate and the speaker of the House of Representatives, shall notify the

1.22 members of the House of Representatives or members of the Senate, respectively, to reassemble

1.23 in a separate and solitary session as deemed necessary by either the speaker of the House of

1.24 Representatives or majority leader of the Senate.

2.1           4. By the adoption of this resolution, each house consents to adjournment of the other house,  
2.2 including the adjournment of the other house at a separate and solitary session under section 3, for  
2.3 more than three days until April 28, 2020.
