1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to education; providing for display or communication of the child abuse  
1.3 hotline number in schools; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes,  
1.4 chapter 121A.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. [121A.07] CHILD ABUSE HOTLINE NUMBER.

1.7 (a) To the extent funds or in-kind contributions are available under paragraph (b), a  
1.8 school board or charter school must display in a conspicuous place in each school building  
1.9 an easily readable durable poster of the national child abuse hotline number or otherwise  
1.10 communicate to students notice of the national child abuse hotline number.

1.11 (b) A school board or charter school may accept nonpublic funds or in-kind contributions  
1.12 to implement this section.
