1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to natural resources; allowing a person age 90 or older to take deer  
1.3 without a license; amending Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 97A.451, by  
1.4 adding a subdivision.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. CITATION.

1.7 Section 2 may be cited as the "Walt Roeschlein Act."

1.8 Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 97A.451, is amended by adding a subdivision  
1.9 to read:

1.10 Subd. 9. Residents 90 years of age or older; deer. A resident age 90 or older may  
1.11 take deer without a license. The resident must obtain the tags required of a licensee,  
1.12 which must be furnished without charge.
