1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to state government; providing for availability of contractors to assist
1.3 state agencies in certain reorganization.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **REORGANIZATION SERVICES UNDER MASTER CONTRACT.**

1.6 By September 1, 2012, the commissioner of administration must make available
1.7 under a master contract program a list of eligible contractors who can assist state agencies
1.8 in:

1.9 (1) reorganization along service rather than functional lines in order to provide
1.10 more efficient and effective service; and

1.11 (2) internal reorganization in order to flatten the organizational structure by requiring
1.12 that decisions are made closer to the service needed, eliminating redundancies, and
1.13 optimizing the span of control ratios to public and private sector industry benchmarks.

1.14 The commissioner of administration must report to the legislature by January
1.15 15, 2013, and January 15, 2014, on state agency use of eligible contractors under this
1.16 section, and on improvements in efficiency and effectiveness of state services as a result of
1.17 services provided by contractors.
