1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to capital investment; appropriating money for the American Indian
1.3 Learning Resource Center at the University of Minnesota, Duluth; authorizing
1.4 the sale and issuance of state bonds.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. AMERICAN INDIAN LEARNING RESOURCE CENTER;
1.7 UNIVERSITY OF MINNESOTA, DULUTH.

1.8 Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$7,350,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
1.9 fund to the Board of Regents of the University of Minnesota to design, construct, furnish,
1.10 and equip an American Indian Learning Resource Center on the Duluth campus to
1.11 colocate existing programs and with space for academic and service programs, classrooms,
1.12 a computer lab, conference rooms, office space, and a great room for gatherings.

1.13 Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the
1.14 bond proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue
1.15 bonds of the state in an amount up to \$7,350,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with
1.16 the effect prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the
1.17 Minnesota Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

1.18 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
