1.6	Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, section 297A.94, \$300,000 in fiscal year 2024 and
1.7	\$300,000 in fiscal year 2025 are appropriated from the heritage enhancement account in
1.8	the game and fish fund for shooting sports facility grants under Minnesota Statutes, section
1.9	87A.10, including grants for archery facilities. Grants must be matched with a nonstate
1.10	match, which may include in-kind contributions. This is a onetime appropriation and is
1.11	available until June 30, 2026. This appropriation must be allocated as follows:
1.12	(1) \$200,000 each fiscal year is for grants of \$25,000 or less; and
1.13	(2) \$100,000 each fiscal year is for grants in excess of \$25,000.
