1.2 relating to taxation; solid waste management; amending allocation of revenues
1.3 from solid waste management tax; amending Minnesota Statutes 2020, section
1.4 297H.13, subdivision 2.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 297H.13, subdivision 2, is amended to read:

1.7 Subd. 2. **Allocation of revenues.** (a) ~~\$33,760,000, or 70 percent, whichever is greater,~~
1.8 Of the amounts remitted under this chapter, 75 percent in fiscal years 2022 and 2023, 80
1.9 percent in fiscal years 2024 and 2025, and 100 percent thereafter must be credited to the
1.10 environmental fund established in section 16A.531, subdivision 1.

1.11 (b) The remainder in fiscal years 2022 to 2025 must be deposited into the general fund.

1.12 (c) Beginning in fiscal year 2022 and continuing each year thereafter, the difference
1.13 between the amount deposited in the environmental fund under paragraph (a) and the amount
1.14 that would have been deposited under paragraph (a) before being amended by this act must
1.15 be expended on activities listed in section 115A.557, subdivision 2, paragraph (a), clauses
1.16 (1) to (7) and (9) to (11).

1.17 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
