1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to state government; requiring monitoring of state grants; specifying when
1.3 a state grant must be terminated; amending Minnesota Statutes 2016, section
1.4 16B.97, by adding a subdivision; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota
1.5 Statutes, chapter 16B.

1.6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.7 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 16B.97, is amended by adding a subdivision
1.8 to read:

1.9 Subd. 6. Commerce grants. The office must monitor grants made by the Department
1.10 of Commerce.

1.11 Sec. 2. [16B.991] TERMINATION OF GRANT.

1.12 Each grant agreement subject to sections 16B.97 and 16B.98 must provide that the
1.13 agreement will immediately be terminated if:

1.14 (1) the recipient is convicted of a criminal offense relating to a state grant agreement;

1.15 or

1.16 (2) the agency entering into the grant agreement or the commissioner of administration
1.17 determines that the grant recipient is under investigation by a federal agency, a state agency,
1.18 or a local law enforcement agency for matters relating to administration of a state grant.
