1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to capital investment; appropriating money for predesign and design of a
1.3 building renovation at the University of Minnesota-Duluth; authorizing the sale
1.4 and issuance of state bonds.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. UNIVERSITY OF MINNESOTA-DULUTH; SCIENCE BUILDING
1.7 RENOVATION.

1.8 Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$1,640,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
1.9 to the Board of Regents of the University of Minnesota to predesign and design a renovation
1.10 of the former chemistry building on the Duluth campus to include active learning classrooms
1.11 and space for the Computer Science and Earth and Environmental Science programs.

1.12 Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
1.13 proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
1.14 the state in an amount up to \$1,640,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
1.15 prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
1.16 Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

1.17 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
