1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to state government; requiring websites maintained by executive branch  
1.3 state agencies to include appropriate contact information, including at a minimum  
1.4 the direct email address of the agency's commissioner or head; amending Minnesota  
1.5 Statutes 2022, section 10.60, subdivision 2.

1.6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.7 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 10.60, subdivision 2, is amended to read:

1.8 Subd. 2. **Purpose of website and publications.** The purpose of a website and a  
1.9 publication must be to provide information about the duties and jurisdiction of a state agency  
1.10 or political subdivision or to facilitate access to public services and information related to  
1.11 the responsibilities or functions of the state agency or political subdivision. A website  
1.12 maintained by an executive branch state agency must also provide appropriate contact  
1.13 information for accessing the agency's primary services, including, at a minimum, the direct  
1.14 email address for the agency's commissioner or head.
