1.3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.4 Section 1. **LABOR AGREEMENTS.**

1.5 Subdivision 1. Minnesota Law Enforcement Association. The labor agreement
1.6 between the state of Minnesota and the Minnesota Law Enforcement Association,
1.7 approved by the Legislative Coordinating Commission Subcommittee on Employee
1.8 Relations on January 15, 2016, is ratified.

1.9 Subd. 2. American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees, Unit
1.10 8. The labor agreement between the state of Minnesota and the American Federation of
1.11 State, County, and Municipal Employees, Unit 8, Corrections Officers, approved by the
1.12 Legislative Coordinating Commission Subcommittee on Employee Relations on January
1.13 15, 2016, is ratified.

1.14 Subd. 3. American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees, Unit
1.15 225. The labor agreement between the state of Minnesota and the American Federation of
1.16 State, County, and Municipal Employees, Unit 225, Radio Communications Operators,
1.17 submitted to the Legislative Coordinating Commission Subcommittee on Employee
1.18 Relations on October 29, 2015, and implemented after 30 days as provided in Minnesota
1.19 Statutes, section 3.855, subdivision 2, is ratified.

1.20 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
