1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to taxation; sales and use; providing an exemption for certain firearm
1.3 safety devices; amending Minnesota Statutes 2023 Supplement, section 297A.67,
1.4 subdivision 40.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2023 Supplement, section 297A.67, subdivision 40, is
1.7 amended to read:

1.8 Subd. 40. **Safety devices; firearm storage units.** (a) Safety devices and secure firearm
1.9 storage units are exempt. For the purposes of this subdivision:

1.10 (1) "safety device" has the meaning given in United States Code, title 18, section
1.11 921(a)(34)(A);

1.12 (2) "secure firearm storage unit" means a container that is fully enclosed and locked by
1.13 a padlock, keylock, combination lock, or similar locking device, and is either specifically
1.14 designed for the safe storage of firearms or sold for that purpose by a federally licensed
1.15 firearms dealer; and

1.16 ~~(2)~~ (3) "firearm" has the meaning provided in section 97A.015, subdivision 19.

1.17 (b) The seller of a safety device or secure firearm storage unit must neither collect, nor
1.18 transmit to any private or public entity, any personal data of or information about a purchaser
1.19 resulting from a sale eligible for the exemption under this subdivision.

1.20 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective for sales and purchases made after June
1.21 30, 2024.
