1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to higher education; establishing a grant program for students pursuing
1.3 law enforcement degree; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes,
1.4 chapter 136A.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. [136A.1213] GRANTS FOR STUDENTS PURSUING LAW
1.7 ENFORCEMENT DEGREE.

1.8 Subdivision 1. Grant amount; eligibility. (a) A student is eligible for a \$1,500 annual
1.9 grant, awarded at the beginning of the academic term and distributed evenly between two
1.10 terms, if the student:

1.11 (1) meets the eligibility requirements in section 136A.121, subdivision 2;

1.12 (2) is enrolled for at least nine credits in a law enforcement associate degree program;
1.13 and

1.14 (3) attends an eligible institution as defined in section 136A.101, subdivision 4.

1.15 (b) The total lifetime limit is \$3,000.

1.16 Subd. 2. Application. To receive a grant under this section, a student must apply in the
1.17 form and manner specified by the commissioner.
