1.6	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 16A.122, subdivision 3, is amended to read:
1.7	Subd. 3. Work force reporting. (a) The commissioner shall prepare quarterly work
1.8	force reports as required for accurate reporting of state employment levels, whether for
1.9	internal analysis or for nationwide comparisons of public employment levels. The reports
1.10	shall <u>:</u>
1.11	(1) express total employment in terms of full-time equivalent positions; shall, itemized
1.12	by agency and by source of funds used to support each position;
1.13	(2) indicate changes from previous reporting periods; and
1.14	(3) if data are available, indicate the number of vacant positions within each agency;
1.15	<u>and</u>
1.16	(4) compare current employment levels with historical data from the previous ten fiscal
1.17	years.
1.18	(b) The reports shall take into account all positions, including full-time, part-time,
1.19	temporary, and other employees. In this subdivision, a full-time equivalent position means
1.20	2,080 working hours per year; except that the number of work hours may vary, depending

1.22	to be included within the definition of a full-time equivalent position.
