.7	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$2,500,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
.8	fund to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to the
.9	city of St. Paul for demolition and site preparation, and to predesign, design, construct,
.10	furnish, and equip a multiservice center on North LaFayette Road in St. Paul. This
.11	appropriation is not available until the commissioner determines that at least an equal
.12	amount is committed to the project from nonstate sources. The city of St. Paul may enter

.14	Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the
