Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2012, section 134A.13, is amended to read:

134A.13 DEPOSITS WITH COUNTY TREASURER; COUNTY AUDITOR.

These fees shall be paid to the county treasurer or county auditor, who shall give a receipt therefor. The county treasurer or county auditor may disburse these funds and any other money belonging to this board only at the direction of the board of trustees. If the board allots funds for technology purposes, the county treasurer or county auditor shall disburse those funds at the direction of the county board.
